RE: Request for larger/higher visibility Speed Limit Signs

Dear

This is in response to your request dated July 02, 2012, wherein you requested the installation of larger/higher visibility speed limit signs along Pine Crest Avenue, in the Idyllwild area.

Traffic Engineering staff reviewed the area on July 23, 2012, to verify existing conditions.

Based on our review, we do not recommend the installation of larger speed limit signs on Pine Crest Avenue. The existing speed limit signs are adequate for this type of roadway. All existing speed limit signs along Pine Crest Avenue are in place and in good working condition. To help remind motorists of the legal speed limit on Pine Crest Avenue, a portable radar speed display trailer was deployed during the week of September 10, 2012. The radar trailer provides feedback to the drivers who may not realize they are exceeding the legal speed limit.

To help increase motorist awareness of the residential zone and potential for pedestrian traffic along Pine Crest Avenue and Riverside Co Playground Rd, pedestrian warning signs were installed along Pine Crest Avenue, west of Marantha Drive and east of Riverside Co Playground Rd. In addition, we installed an additional 25 mile-per-hour speed limit sign on Riverside Co Playground Rd, north of SH-243. All recommended signs were installed on September 25, 2012.
